Ireland's Daniel Coyle Dominates \$35,000 Jumper Classic at **Ottawa International**

Ottawa, Ontario Daniel Coyle of Ireland claimed both first and second to dominate \$35,000 AECON Jumper Classic at the CSI3* Ottawa International Horse Show on Sunday, July 23, at Wesley Clover Parks in Ottawa, ON.

In a dramatic conclusion to two weeks of world-class show jumping competition, 22 entries faced off over the Anthony D'Ambrosio-designed course with eight horse and rider combinations advancing to the jump-off.

Coyle was the first to return for the tie-breaking round, setting the time to
