

That's why Liv Gude, a former international dressage groom and the founder of <a href="ProEquineGrooms.com">ProEquineGrooms.com</a>, is sharing a few tips to help your horse beat the heat!:

- Monitor your horse's temperature both before and after rides.
- Check your horse's gums frequently for signs of dehydration. His upper teeth should be slimy and slick. Sticky or dry gums are dangerous and are a sign to call the vet right away!
- Take your time cooling your horse down, offering water right away and rinsing with water or a water/alcohol bath once he is cool. Alcohol evaporates faster and helps speed up the cooling process.
- Consider clipping your horse in the summer for added temperature control. (You can see Liv's clipping tips here!)

## 501(c)3 Spotlight: L.E.A.R.N. Horse Rescue

In the spring of 2009, South Carolina Animal Control executed the second largest animal seizure in the history of the state, removing 47 horses from a local farm following continued complaints to the authorities of the horses' abuse and neglect. Recognizing the dire need for homes for these horses – many of which were in extremely poor physical condition – one South Carolina resident, Elizabeth Steed, took on the care and rescue of 33 of them.

It was from that event and out of crisis and necessity that the <u>Livestock & Equine Awareness & Rescue</u>
<u>Network (L.E.A.R.N.) Horse Rescue</u> was born!


