



Foreign ticket sales for next year's Olympic Games in Tokyo are set to be launched on or after June 14. Tickets were expected to go on sale to the public in Japan at the end of this April. Previously, the domestic phase of ticket sales for Olympic Games has been simultaneous with the international release.



Breakdancing, sport climbing, skateboarding, and surfing have been put forward for inclusion as additional sports on the program for the 2024 Olympic Games in Paris. The International Olympic Committee will debate the merits of each before deciding the worthiness of including them.

The Equestrian Events of the 2024 Olympic Games will take place on the grounds of the UNESCO World Heritage site, the Château de Versailles, about 16 km from Paris.

## Ottawa doubles FEI weeks

Two weeks of FEI-sanctioned show jumping competition will be offered at the Ottawa International Horse Show, July 10-14 and July 17-21, 2019, at Wesley Clover Parks in Ottawa, ON. Formerly a national-level competition the first week, it has been upgraded to a CSI2\* while the second week remains a CSI3\* event, giving riders double the opportunity to compete for FEI world ranking points.
