Instead of going back and forth, prepare all horses' meals and put them into a wheelbarrow or add feed and supplements to wheeled cart with compartments so that you can roll down the aisle way, stopping at each stall as you go. 


Meet BarnManager and the **Equine Tech Collab at WIHS!**
