



Max Amaya wakes up seven days a week with the same level of drive and intensity that saw him dedicate his life to horses 28 years ago. "Every day I wake up and I say, 'I don't want to fail. I don't want to not be able to achieve this. I want this horse to be well. I want this horse to do good. I want this rider to succeed,' " said Amaya, 46. "In my personal space, I can only be in charge of my actions to not fail. When I'm dealing with riders and students, not only do I have to try to not fail myself, but also, I have to persuade that person to not give up in order not to fail. So, it's challenging, but it's what keeps me going."




