

- **Cabins** Each of the cabins sleeps up to six guests and is within walking distance from the arenas and barns. Two of the cabins are handicap accessible. Free Wi-Fi included.
- Home Away from Home Park Directly across the street from the horse show entrance, the 130 Home Away from Home units have two or three bedrooms with a fully-equipped kitchen and living and dining room area. Free Wi-Fi included.
- **RV Sites** World Equestrian Center has many RV sites equipped with electric, water and sewer for \$175 per week (or any portion thereof). You must reserve these on your entry form or stall reservation form. Please check in at the horse show office for a pass prior to parking your RV.
