


increased water requirements during extremely hot days. Sodium in the horse's diet is essential to maintaining proper hydration. Providing a salt block or supplementing with electrolytes can help ensure that the horse is meeting its sodium requirements and encourage drinking.



In addition to lack of sweat, signs of Anhidrosis can include increased respiratory rate, elevated temperature, areas of hair loss, or dry, flaky skin. If

any of these signs are noticed, contact a veterinarian immediately.

The treatment of Anhidrosis includes a few simple changes. All horses should have access to shade and cool water throughout the day. Any exercise should be scheduled when the temperatures are lower, usually



Another common treatment for Anhidrosis is adding dark beer to their feed, such as Guinness. Some cases require more significant treatment, and commercial products are available to help as well. Getting Paperwork Organized for an FEI Competition: The Passport

The FEI requires a passport renewal every four years. The first step is to check to make sure your horse's passport is current. Usually, you can find the expiration date on the front cover of the passport, though some passports have a more recent revalidation sticker on the back cover. If you need to renew your horse's passport, and that is the only issue with it, you can submit a "Passport Service Application" to USEF, and they will send you a revalidation sticker in the mail. If there is anything else that needs to be updated with the passport, you will have to send the passport in to USEF along with the application. If your horse has never had a passport, or an old passport is lost, you can submit the "Passport Service Application" to the USEF for a new one.
