Five Questions With the Ilan Ferder Stables Team

Meet Ashlee Bond

How long have you been riding, and how did you get involved with horses? I have been riding since I was three years old. My dad put me on a horse when I was six months old. Both my parents grew up with horses but my dad was actively riding. He did cutting, polo, and then when I was about seven years old he made the switch to show jumping.

How long have you been catch riding for Ilan and how did that relationship start?

I started catch riding for Ilan recently. My dad has actually known Ilan since he first came from Israel when Ilan was in his early 20s. Ilan sold us Cadett 7 and Chivas Z. Some of my best horses have come from Ilan so we developed a friendship over the years.

How did you start riding Chill Ma, and what is your relationship like with her? Ilan said he had a mare that would really suit me. He had me come to his farm, then I jumped her at home on a Thursday and again the following Tuesday. That Friday we showed in the 1.40m and were double clear and sixth. We decided to put her in the grand prix later that week and she won. The next week we went straight into the 1.40m and won and then did the grand prix and won again. She goes around like a big hunter. She is super fast but not super hot, which I like because I think a lot of people could ride her. I feel like I could put my daughter on her because she is so safe and chill. Her name really suits her! She is a blast and super careful, scopey, and talented. I feel like her style and my style really suit each other so she seems to really trust me.

What do you enjoy most about riding horses for Ilan?

I would say llan is known for finding incredibly talented horses that are top quality. I can't always afford to get those types of horses unless I get them when they are very young. It is a treat to be able to ride a nine-year-old that is ready to go and win at a high level. Since he keeps the horses at his farm I'm literally catch riding them at the show, which is really fun. I think it's great for my riding to be put on different horses and learn to adapt. It will make me a better rider.

What is one of your favorite horse show memories?

One of my favorite horse show memories is jumping clear in Tokyo on Donatello 141 or "Donnie." It was a dream come true for my team, my country, myself, and my family.
